The Symposium

The Hellenic Archaeological Society (EAE) is pleased to announce [the program](#) of the 8th Symposium of Archaeometry, entitled "Archaeometry beyond Analysis: Interpretive Approaches", which will be held with the support of the [Byzantine and Christian Museum](#), on October 17-20, 2023.

In the proceedings of the Symposium, approximately 100 original scientific papers by Greek and foreign experts are meant to address important research issues in Eastern Mediterranean and beyond, also covering almost all areas of modern Archaeometry studies. It is of special importance that this year's Symposium has attracted the interest of Archaeologists and experts from the Physical Sciences as attested in many papers, as well as the prominent presence of young scientists both with oral and poster presentations.

Oral presentations will have a **15 minute slot**, with an additional 5 minutes for questions. The official languages of the Symposium are Greek and English. In case you wish to deliver your presentation in Greek, it would be desirable to use the English language on the slides.

Poster announcements should be made with poster dimensions: 80x120 cm in portrait orientation (A0 dimensions).

The [Symposium Dinner](#) will take place on Thursday 19/10, at 20:00 at [Café Avissinia](#). The cost of participation is set at 25 euros/person. Reservation and prepayment are required. The closing date for reservation and payment for the Dinner is Wednesday, October 11. Participants who have not paid the full registration fees are also welcome in the Symposium Dinner.

The **Conference Reception** will take place on 17/10, at 18:30 in the forecourt of the Byzantine and Christian Museum. Participation is free, but registration is required by Wednesday, October 11. Participants who have not paid the full registration fees are also welcome at the Conference Reception.

Please note that those who have not submitted a scientific paper (oral or poster) can attend the proceedings of the Symposium as described below:

- One-day attendance of the Symposium: €30 (includes conference material, coffee breaks/light lunch).
- Attendance of 2 days or more: €60 (includes conference material, coffee breaks/light lunch).
- Simple attendance without registration: free of charge (conference material, coffee breaks **NOT included**).

Payment for attendance by registration is also possible during Symposium registration periods.

A certificate of attendance/participation will be provided only with the completion of registration.

Proceedings of the Symposium will be published in [AURA](#), an international peer-reviewed journal published annually by the Department of History and Archaeology of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens. The Journal is free and open access and its issues are published online as pdf files. Papers are freely available to everyone online immediately after publication and under the Creative Commons CC BY-NC-ND 4.0 license.

The publication plan is set to 1 year after the start of submissions. More details will be announced after the Symposium.
